Cricut Project Instruction Established Sign Frame

Directions:

- 1. Open Cricut Design Space.
- 2. Click "New Project" to open a new project canvas.
- 3. Click "Shapes."
- 4. Insert the square shape.
- 5. Click the "lock" icon on the bottom left of the shape.
- 6. Pull the square into a rectangle shape. Size it to a 5" x 7".
- 7. Click the "text" icon.
- 8. In your desired text, write "est."
- 9. Create a new text box.
- 10. Place the year in the text box.
- 11. Using the frame shape and a measuring tape (if needed), estimate where the words should go on the rectangle.
- 12. Attach the words to the rectangle shape, placing them in the correct location.
- 13. Send the image to the Cricut machine, cutting on the LightGrip cutting mat and white card stock.
- 14. Remove the card stock from the cutting mat. Check it with the Buck and Doe Heart Craft Shape and the frame for placement before securing with Glue Dots®. If the placement is satisfactory, continue to step 17. If it is not, repeat steps 13, 14 and 15.
- 15. Spray paint the Buck and Doe Heart Craft Shape. Let dry completely.
- 16. On the reverse side of the Buck and Doe Heart Craft Shape, apply Glue Dots® Advanced Strength Dots, folding them as needed to fit the size of the shape.
- 17. Adhere the Buck and Doe Heart Craft Shape to the white piece of card stock, centering the year in the Buck and Doe Heart Craft Shape.
- 18. On the back side of the white card stock, apply Glue Dots® Advanced Strength Dots around the edges.
- 19. Press the white card stock to the front of the frame backer.
- 20. Insert into the frame.
